This is the full version of The Paranormalist's Halloween Photo Hunt, in a simple-print format. (It is less portable than the booklet format that is also available, but it has larger print and does not require folding.) While the full version of the hunt can be used for a relatively short scavenger hunt, it is best suited for playing over extended periods. (Think the whole day, the weekend, or the entire Halloween season.)
